Re: Airport Security-Drive through Gates

This is a reminder that airport security is EVERYONE'S business. That includes airside access through the sliding gates. There is to be no more than 1 vehicle entry/exit per opening of the electric gate. "Piggy Backing", or following closely to preclude a gate closure between vehicles is not permitted

The protocol is to pass through the gate and wait for closure. While the gate is open, YOU are responsible for ensuring that no other vehicle passes. This includes entry and exit. Sanctions for violations include revocation of vehicular airside access.
