HAMPTON ROADS ALLIANCE QUESTIONNAIRE

Mr. Schrantz discussed the Hampton Roads Alliance Questionnaire regarding uncrewed aircraft. A consensus of the members agreed with the Manager's recommendation to respond to the Alliance that the Authority is interested in further exploration.

MANAGER'S REPORT submitted by Chris Schrantz

- 1. Budget meeting for 2026 Operating Budget is scheduled for 1/23/25. The Authority submits a request to the city to maintain current level funding as well as a request for increased funding due to increased costs. At this time, the Authority is reimbursed wages and only a portion of storm water fees. Storm water fees are paid back to the City. All other operating revenue for the Authority comes from rents and charges paid by users of the airport.
- 2. C Hangar complex electrical service has been restored.
- 3. Legislative reception is being held in Richmond on 1/25 and legislative day will be held on 1/30/25. The legislative day gives the opportunity for the Virginia Airport Operators Council to thank legislators for funding airport projects around the Commonwealth
- 4. Snow removal on 1/11/25 was done by skid steer in the parking lot. The runway was opened at 10:00 AM.
- 5. The Manager and the Strategic Communications Committee have reviewed and recommend responding to the Hampton Roads Alliance questionnaire for opportunity exploration.
